CERTIFICATE IN MANAGEMENT AND SOFT SKILLS

English Communication is one of the prominent courses of the National University Students' Skill Development programme, which is a notable outcome of the initiative of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports in collaboration with the National Skill Development Agency (NSDA). I compliment the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, and NSDA on launching a programme of prime national importance. This ambitious project, which is at the cutting edge of skill and language development, is a dynamic collaboration between the English and Foreign Languages University (EFLU) and the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), Mumbai. The course itself is the result of a series of meetings between EFLU and representatives of NSDA and TISS. The primary aim of the course is to help undergraduate students across the country improve their communication skills in general and employability skills in particular. As language learning is chiefly skill-based, the student's book has been specifically designed as a series of activities intended to give learners crucial practice in using English effectively. In addition to the Student Activity Book, there is a supporting Teacher's Handbook that is designed to enable teachers to help students maximize their learning on the course.

OUTCOME

- locate and understand specific information contained in notices, instructions, signs, product descriptions;
- locate and understand information contained in simple informative texts (e.g. newspaper stories, encyclopedias, and short descriptive reports on familiar matters; and infer the meaning of words from context.

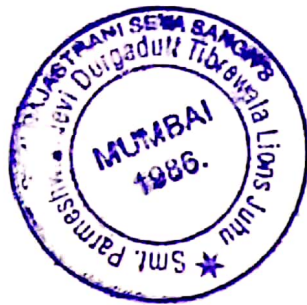

DIPLOMA IN BANKING AND FINANCIAL SERVICES(FOR THIRD YEAR STUDENTS)

The employability of India's university graduates continues to remain weak even while there is an acute shortage of skilled manpower in an increasing number of high demand sectors. The youth are thus disillusioned about job opportunities post their studies. Though they have educational degrees, they lack the skills and the experience to get employed. The Tata Institute of Social Sciences has been working to reach the youth through an innovative programme called 'National University Students; Skill Development (NUSSD)' for the same purpose. The aim is to enable the youth enrolled in the various degree programs in Colleges and Universities in India to acquire skills that would give them a Certificate/Diploma in a specific high demand domain area in addition to their degree. Students will be introduced to holistic education which encompasses components of employment oriented training, exposure to community services, life skills training and civic education to fulfill the changing requirement of higher education and thereby bringing about vocationalisation of higher education. Eventually, this programme is poised to cover all the youth in the university system wanting to enhance their employment potential by gaining skills along with a graduate degree in their chosen discipline.

OUTCOME:

- Having a Powerful TISS Certification on their CVs gives them, a competitive advantage over their peers.
- The Online Sessions by seasoned Finance Professionals' empower them with world class, comprehensive learning experience.
- This enrollment will not only help them in their ongoing studies, understanding the concepts well, but also will help them get better grades, in the forthcoming Final Year Examination.

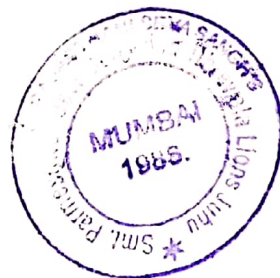
Earn while you learn (EWYL) Training with placement assistance at zero cost

Kotak education foundation programme for students who're facing extreme hardships in life, and whose academic performance is suffering as a result.
