Yoga Day Report 2022-2023

The Third International Day of Yoga was celebrated on June 21, 2022 by the National Service Scheme unit of S.P.D.T. College with great enthusiasm. Introductory and practice sessions of Yoga for the same were organized on June 21, 2022 in room No: 104.


COLLEGE WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL ACTIVITIES 2022-23




